There are two categories, Serious and Social. Due to an age handicap and the average age of competitors a Masters category has become obsolete.

Team Result

To qualify for a team result, the best run time of the top four racers in each team will be totalled. Based off that total your team will receive points. The 4 races with the highest points for your team will be totalled and the team with the most points will be the winners. The handicap will be applied to the best run.

If you have two Serious people on your team and the rest are Social your team will need to be considered as a Serious team.

Individual Result

Top male and female of each category will be announced at the Après at Lone Star each week; you will receive bragging rights until the following race.



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Handicap

Your age = 2019 – year of birth (as of July 1st)

In order to calculate the handicap it is important that we know the **Date of Birth** of each participant.

The Handicap will be applied per run.

Age	Handicap (Seconds)
30-39	0.25
40-49	0.5
50-59	0.75
60-69	1
70 & up	1.25
Female	0.25
Telemark	0.5
Snowboarder	1

Points system for both individual and team scoring will follow the Masters. 1st= 100 points, 2nd=80 points, 3rd= 60 points, 4th = 50 points, below 30th will receive zero points.
