- 01 Finishing off the Sugar Bowl Basin development by widening Cross Fall trail to 45m and Serpentine trail to 25m
- 02 Installing 6 more TR8 fan snow guns and 18 V3 Lance snow guns along Cross Fall and Serpentine trails
- 03 Increased car parking capacity at the base of the mountain access road
- 04 Improving reliability of power supply to the base building.
- 05 Planting over 800 native trees in a 1ha plot along the access road

Along with sister mountains Coronet Peak and Mt Hutt, The Remarkables is dedicated to Kaitiakitanga, focusing on continued restoration and enhancement of our environment.

A dedicated scheduled bus service operates throughout the day from the center of Queenstown with options of pre-arranged hotel pick ups en-route.

SNOWMAKING

Extensive automated system comprising 148 guns covering beginners' area, Alta Green, Casterway, Gotham City, Curvey, Crossfall, Serpentine, Turquoise, Waterfall, and terrain parks.

LIFTS

2 high-speed six-seater chairs, 2 quad chairs, 4 surface conveyor lifts including two with covered galleries.

AVERAGE SNOWFALL 3.67m per annum (excl. snowmaking).

ACCESS 28km, 45min from Queenstown (9km sealed and 4km unsealed access road) from Queenstown.

TERRAIN 30% beginner, 40% intermediate, 30% advanced.

NON SKIERS Chairlift to sightseeing access point and a toboggan area.

SNOWSPORTS Private and group coaching available as well as high performance camps and adaptive programmes.

KIDS PROGRAMMES Ages 4-5years & 5-17 years.

FOOD & BEVERAGE Restaurant and bar services, cafe, Corona Ice Bar.

RENTALS Full Head & Salomon recreational and performance rental gear available as well as an on-mountain workshop for equipment tuning.
